Day Trips

Where, What to Bring, What NOT to Bring, What to Wear

Where: We will be departing from the Beluga Air float plane dock, [located at 3409 Lampert Loop on Beluga Lake](#) in Homer. Prior to departure each person will need to sign a Participant Agreement and Emergency Contact Form.

What to Bring

- Lunch and snacks - please avoid bringing tuna, salmon, or any other fish.
- Water - enough to last the day. Please bring all water bottles FULL.
- Handsfree day pack - large enough to carry your equipment, clothing, & lunch (NO totes, duffels, grocery bags, coolers, etc.)
- Binoculars
- Camera with a 100-400mm zoom lens or similar focal length, extra batteries, memory cards.
- Insect repellent
- Sun screen
- Medications - any that you regularly take, bring enough for two days.
- Trekking poles (if trekking poles are needed, collapsible models are preferable)

What NOT to Bring

- Bear Spray or Bear Flares
- Firearms or Weapons of any kind

What to Wear - a layered approach to clothing works best.

- Jacket – a warm puffy jacket like a Patagonia Nano Puff or a fleece jacket (medium to heavyweight fleece) which can worn under your rain jacket.
- Light weight rain gear – **with both a jacket and pants.**
- Gloves - a light weight pair or a of pair synthetic glove liners
- Hat or baseball cap
- Long pants - do not wear shorts.
- 2 pairs of socks (1 thin and 1 thick). This helps get a proper fit for the hip boots we provide.
